#### DESCRIPTION

This qualification provides learners with opportunities to continue to engage in the workforce and/or to assist, coordinate and lead teams in communities and government agencies to undertake roles such as: gathering relevant information and data for monitoring and reporting of projects in Resilience or on a particular field of Resilience (agriculture, energy and infrastructure, coastal management, fisheries, forestry, health, tourism, water resources), and developing community awareness on matters related to vulnerability, climate change adaptation, mitigation and disaster risk reduction.

#### CAREER OPPORTUNITIES

Job roles and titles vary across different industry sectors. Possible job titles relevant to this qualification include: Climate Change Advisor, In-country Coordinator, Project Coordinator, Consultant on Climate Change and Resilience, Climate Change Policy Advisor.

#### ELIGIBILITY/ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

To be admitted to this programme, a person:

- (i) Pass in Senate recognised year 12 with English and a minimum of 2 years of relevant work experience; or
- (ii) Met the mature student admission criteria; or
- (iii) Completion of Certificate III in Resilience; or
- (iv) Any special case where the above requirements are not met can be approved by the Director or nominee on case by case basis
